

ROCKFORD AREA ARTS AWARDS NOMINATION FORM

The Rockford Area Arts Council, Mayor Thomas McNamara, and Winnebago County Board Chair Frank Haney are pleased to present the Rockford Area Arts Awards (formerly known as the Mayor's Arts Awards). These awards, both a continuation of the that program begun by Mayor John McNamara, and a new beginning for Mayor McNamara, along with Chairman Haney, will honor the exceptional artists, advocates, organizations and arts supporters who reside in our region. The awards ceremony will take place Wednesday, February 21 from 5:00-7:00PM at the Rockford Art Museum. Awards will be given in the following categories: Individual Artist, Arts Advocate, Community Impact, and Creative Arts & Cultural Event. *(Past recipients of Mayor's Arts Awards may be nominated.)*

2018 ROCKFORD AREA ARTS AWARDS

Nominees will be evaluated on the basis of the breadth and depth of their work and its impact on the Rockford area (Winnebago and/or Boone County). A peer panel will review nominations based on the four evaluation criteria below.

AWARD CATEGORIES

Individual Artist

Honors an artist whose achievements and commitment to the arts have generated a significant and positive impact on the community over a period of time.

Arts Advocate

Honors an individual whose efforts in advocacy, support, and/or volunteerism in the arts have generated a significant positive impact on the community over a period of time.

Community Impact Award

Honors a business that recognizes the importance of the arts through financial or in-kind support, use of the arts in the workplace, and/or encouragement of employees to volunteer for the arts, or otherwise serves as an advocate for the arts.

Creative Arts & Cultural Event Award

Recognizes an exhibit, performance, festival, series, or special event during the 2016-2017 season (in Winnebago and/or Boone County) which brought heightened visibility to the arts. The nominated event must have occurred sometime between November 1, 2016 through October 31, 2017).

HOW TO SUBMIT A NOMINATION

Preference will be given to those who have not received an award in the past. The Rockford Area Arts Council office must receive your nomination on or before January 5, 2018. Nominees will be listed in the program at the Rockford Area Arts Council's awards ceremony on Wednesday, February 21 from 5-7:00 pm at the Rockford Art Museum.

Nomination Packet should include:

- A completed nomination form.
- Letter from nominator.
- One additional Letter of Support describing your nominee's contributions to the arts in the Rockford area and describing what makes the nominee deserving of an award.
- For Individual Artist Nominee: Include documentation of artistic work: i.e. website link, digital photos, video, etc.

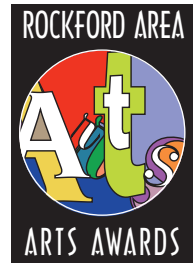
Letters of Support should address, and will be the basis for evaluation for the following*:

- **Artistic Merit:** Describe the artistic medium and the quality of the nominee's work in this discipline.
- **Longevity:** How long has the individual or business served the Rockford metropolitan area? Which institutions has the individual served, and for how long (include teaching appointments, schools attended, boards, volunteer, and/or staff roles)?
- **Breadth of Work:** Describe the projects or causes that the nominee has been involved in. How many individuals or businesses have been served through the nominee's work?
- **Impact:** What impact has the nominee's work or service had on the arts and in our community? How many people were served by the work?
